

Appointment Breakdown

Caregiver training in the treatment of challenging behavior

1. Intake

This appointment involves caregivers answering questions about their child's daily routine and behavior while another student therapist plays with the child and conducts assessments to discover the child's communication abilities and preferred activities. Typically, caregivers watch the assessment in another room and provide additional helpful information. Occasionally, caregivers might be asked to participate in the assessment



1-1.5 hours

Fee: \$75

2. Assessment

This appointment includes a student therapist running an assessment on the child to determine why the behavior is occurring. While this is happening, the caregivers will be in another room watching this assessment and providing additional information to a student therapist.

3. Treatment Recommendations

Treatment Recommendations appointment includes student therapists presenting data they have collected and describing treatment for the caregivers to implement in the home. They provide models and train parents until they can accurately implement treatment and describe data collection. Finally, they answer any questions and provide all necessary materials for treatment.

4. Follow-up One

Follow-up one includes reviewing data collected by caregivers, troubleshooting any issues or resolving any questions that resulted from treatment. Also, student therapists will analyze data to see if the treatment is effective and make any necessary changes.

5. Follow-Up Two

Follow-up two includes reviewing additional data, answering questions and determining if there is a need for additional appointments. Typically, this is the last appointment.
