KFETS Logging and Tracking

- Go to <http://www.epsb.ky.gov/> and log in (same as previous semester)
- Be sure to choose new semester, year and class!
- 6 = 1 day; 3 = ½ day; 0 = <½ day - Log EACH DAY
- Can duplicate each day as before.
- Not required to journal or note unless your instructor or supervisor requires it.
 - If NTI or Substitute Teaching, please note that in the comments section
- CHOOSE CATEGORY B

Substitute Teaching Policy

- You may not substitute teach within the first 2 weeks/10 days of your placement
- Maximum of 20 days can be used as sub and count toward student teaching.
- You stay in your current classroom - the teacher moves to the room needed
- You get paid for being a substitute teacher
- You do not have to sub if you do not want to

Snow Day Policies

- Most districts have a NTI (Non Traditional Instruction)
- CAN count NTI towards student teaching days
- If no NTI, you cannot count a day toward student teaching
- If packet-based, be sure that you are actively planning, calling students, etc. on the NTI day.
- Note "NTI Day" on your KFETS tracking

COVID-19 Policies

- If you are exhibiting symptoms, please go get tested or test at home!!!!
- Follow masking requirements in your district
- If you are exposed then you can continue in your placement
 - You may or may not get exposure notifications
- If you test positive for Covid-19 you are required to isolate for 6 days before returning to placement
 - Please notify your supervisor and CT if you test positive
 - Day 0 is first day of symptoms
 - After day 5, then you can return to placement if no symptoms - wear a mask for 5 more days
 - After day 5, if you still have symptoms, please see a provider
- Please keep your teacher and supervisor updated!!

CPAST Unit Wide Assessment
