Who We Are:

UK-CABS is a graduate student-ran behavior clinic that focuses on helping you:

- Identify WHY your child is engaging in a target behavior
- Decrease one target behavior
- Increase appropriate and/or alternative behaviors

Graduate student therapists are obtaining their master's degrees in applied behavior analysis (ABA) and are receiving education and training to become a board certified behavior analyst (BCBA). All services provided are overseen by a currently certified BCBA.

Because we are a parent-training clinic, your child's success is largely dependent on your participation in implementing the recommended behavior plan. Once you are trained, you will be responsible for collecting data and following through with the program at home.
