What is this Service?

Does your child need additional support to communicate with you and engage in age-appropriate play? Would you like tips and strategies on how to make the most of your time with your child? Then this program may be a great fit for you! As part of this program, we are focused on promoting engagement and communication in your child and empowering families with strategies to promote skills at home and related settings utilizing principles of Applied Behavior Analysis. As part of our student learning clinic, all sessions will be led by a team of master's level students and overseen by a Board Certified Behavior Analyst.

Overview of Appointments

- Appointment 1: This appointment will be 2 hours and will include a series of observations and assessments of your child's communication, play, and related skills, like imitation.
- Appointments 2-6: Two weeks after the initial assessment, there will be
 weekly 1 hour appointments. We will focus on working with you and your
 child throughout the duration of each visit. During each session, graduate
 students work directly with your child to promote communication and
 engagement and then spend time training you to use similar strategies.
- **Virtual Meetings**: Between appointments, we also offer optional meetings online or over the phone to check in and discuss any questions you may have.
