## **Certification Application Information**

### **Day Tracking in KFETS**

A passing grade cannot be assigned to a student who has not recorded enough time in the classroom to meet the state's 70-day minimum requirement. Time spent in the student teaching classroom will be documented as full (6) or half (3) days online in the KFETS system for a required minimum total of 420 hours. Post entries daily! August 11 First day of student teaching in Fayette County
August 13 First day of school with students in Fayette County

September 1 Labor Day- no school Sept. 29- Oct. 3 Fall Break in Fayette County

October 10 Last day of first placement for students in dual placements

October 13 First day of second placement for students in dual placements

November 26-28 Thanksgiving Break in Fayette County

December 5 Last day of placement for students in dual placements- if no make-up days needed

December 16 Last day of placements for students in the elementary program- if no make-up days needed
