The program will accept General Education requirements as stated above. Since COM 181 and STA 200 are no longer offered at UK and since they were also part of University Studies requirements, the program will allow students to take a sufficient number of extra elective hours to complete a minimum of 120 hours to fulfill graduation requirements.

<sup>1</sup> Note that MA 109 is NOT approved as a Quantitative Foundations course. Students in a major requiring calculus will use a calculus course (MA 113, 123 or 137) while students not requiring calculus should take MA 111, PHI 120 or another approved course.




