Due to the advent of General Education, the MSD program related studies area will require one physical science course and one biological science course to be chosen with the help of an advisor. (Currently the program requires either a physical science or a biological science pair in the USP Natural Science requirement, and a pair in the other science grouping in Program Related Studies.) The remaining credits will be made up in electives chosen with the help of an advisor, to bring the total number of earned hours up to 120.

¹ Note that MA 109 is NOT approved as a Quantitative Foundations course. Students in a major requiring calculus will use a calculus course (MA 113, 123, 137 or 138) while students not requiring calculus should take MA 111, PHI 120 or another approved course.


